# REQUEST FOR QUOTATION

## 1.0 PURPOSE

The intent of this Request for Quotation is to purchase a portable network surveillance camera system to set up wireless IP based perimeter video surveillance. The product should meet minimally the below specifications:

## 2.0 COMPETITION INTENDED

It is the City's intent that this Request for Quotation (RFQ) permits competition. It shall be the bidder's responsibility to advise the Buyer if any language requirement, specification, etc., or any combination thereof, inadvertently restricts or limits the requirements stated in this RFQ to a single source.

## 3.0 SPECIFICATIONS

### 3.1 Cameras:

- A. 4 self contained, battery operated wireless network cameras in a ruggedized case waterproof with wheels
- B. Cameras should be Day/Night Pan Tilt Zoom cameras with 10x optical zoom and IR illumination that can be controlled remotely
- C. PTZ will remotely allow operator to pan 360 degrees, and tilt from -45 degrees to 90 degrees, and adjust 10x optical zoom.
- D. IR illumination must be invisible to be used covertly
- E. Must be able to automatically switch from color to black and white and IR dependant and upon light levels
- F. Each camera must come with 4.5 foot telescoping pole camera tilt/swivel bracket, pole tilt-swivel bracket
- G. Cameras must be rugged and weather resistant
- H. Can be programmed to generate motion alarms.
- I. Must be able to transmit video on a wireless 802.11 network, either connecting to an existing structured network, or creating its own standalone network

### 3.2 Wireless Network:

- A. Self contained battery operated wireless network device that digitally transmits video to a remote laptop, PC or phone device. Can be body worn or pole mounted.
- B. Frequency 2.4GHz, 802.11 b/g
- C. 12" omni directional whip antenna with 6 foot antenna cable supplied. Antenna can be mounted directly to the case or on the pole
- D. 6 foot antenna cable
- E. The video must be able to be viewed and/or recorded by a PC connected to the network and running its own application program.
- F. Can be configured to share encrypted video with team members on phone or PC devices
- G. Must be able to minimally support four cameras per network
- H. Range of minimally 1300 line of sight dependent upon environment

### 3.3 Batteries:

- A. Removable lead acid battery with 6 hour recharge time
- B. 1 Battery Charger
- C. 1 power supply
- D. Vehicle adaptor cable
- E. 1 mounting bracket
- F. 1 hard foam fitted case

### 3.4 PC Monitoring Station:

- A. Application program that allows for system set up and configuration, allowing all cameras to be viewed simultaneously or independently

- B. Programmable motion detector and low battery alarm for each camera (List as optional)
- C. Semi ruggedized Intel core Duo 2.4 GHz or faster, at least 2 GB of RAM, Video card with NVidia 7600 chipset or newer with at least 256 MB of RAM, 801.11 b/g wireless network adaptor; Operating system- Windows XP, Windows 2003 server, Windows Vista Enterprise or Business only

  - C. NOTICES, ADVERTISEMENTS, AND SOLICITATIONS PLACED IN ACCORDANCE WITH FEDERAL LAW, RULE OR REGULATION SHALL BE DEEMED SUFFICIENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF MEETING THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
