The Request for Proposal (RFP) for Intelligent Street Light System has been amended.

The following questions and answers are incorporated in the bid:

Q1: How many total luminaires does the City of Suffolk own?

A1: This information is unavailable.

Q2: Is there a mixture of decorative and cobra head style luminaires? If there is a mixture what is the percentage of each?

A2: There are both types of fixtures in the city. Both types may or may not be included in a management system. The exact percentage is unknown, but the majority are cobra head types.

Q3: Is this RFP to actually purchase the system or for the City to standardize on a product?

A3: Standardize on a system and purchase a system in the near future as part of a larger project.

Q4: What are the expectations of the control system? Examples: monitoring, work order management, scheduling, additional components such as cameras, weather devices, gunshot detection, etc.

A4: It is possible for any or all of the noted functions to be in the system.

Q5: If this system were to have some type of failure, does the city still want the smart photocell (Node) to operate as a standard photocell?

Q6: Does each luminaire have its own photocell or does a lightning cabinet with a contractor control a bank of luminaires from a central point?

A6: Both situations may be possible.
