The Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for Master Plan for Airport Maintenance Building has been amended. The following are hereby made a part of the Contract Documents for IFB 19088-JS as fully and completely as if the same were fully set forth therein:

The following questions and answers are incorporated in the RFP:

Q1: Is the City expecting there will be a FF & E requirement for this project?

A1: Other than the required bathroom fixtures that are identified in the specification, there is not furniture required as part of this project.

Q2: The RFQ says that the existing structure being replaced is to be disassembled (Will it be reused or just discarded?) and construct "a" new structure with wood columns, beams, trusses and girts.

Could the new building be a pre-engineered metal building in lieu of wood timber framing? Is this wood structural system preferred due to cost and/or are all your other existing structures built this way?

A2: The existing building shall be removed from the airport property by the Contractor, it will not be reused on-site. The proposed building is identified with wood columns, beams, trusses and girts to control construction costs. A pre-engineered metal building can be considered but it may be cost prohibitive.

All other information remains unchanged.
