The Request for Information (RFI) for RFI 21031-JS for the Electronic Document Management System (EDMS) for the Department of Information Technology been amended.

Q1: The City's inquiry is for a day-forward Electronic Document Management Solution for document repository and workflow processes correct?

**A1: Yes**

Q2: Per Q18 on addendum 1, OnBase seems to be referred to as a current application you all are utilizing. Please confirm if so.

**A2: Yes. Hosted on-Premises**

Q3: Approximately how many unique users would need access to the system, grouped in terms of administrators, power users, and search/view-only users?

**A3: Currently the City cannot provide this number.**

Q4: Is there (or can there be) a preference for Virginia-based companies?

**A4: Preferences for Virginia companies are not permitted**

Q5: Does the City have a preference for on-premise or cloud-based EDMS solutions?

**A5: The City does not have a preference at this time.**

Q6: Is there a desire or benefit in a system that can also manage physical records?

**A6: Yes**

Q7: Is there a desire or benefit to acquire a system that is certified against DoD 5015.02 for Electronic Records Management?

A7: Yes

Q8: Is there a desire or benefit for the EDMS to include a public-facing portal?

A8: Not at this time.

Q9: Does the City own existing scanning hardware and/or software, and if so, which scanning software package(s)?

A9: The software is Application Xtender. The hardware is any scanner link to the software

Q10: Is there a budget ceiling that has been identified for this acquisition?

A10: This has not been determined.

Q11: What concerns or constraints, if any, does the City perceive with a potential EDMS project?

A11: Not having the ability to scanned various documents and storage.

Q12: Is there a defined scope of services for implementing the solution or is the City looking at software pricing only at this time?

A12: Actually we a look for a EDMS solution

Q13: Are integrations with City or 3rd-party systems in-scope? If so, can the City please provide a list of systems?

A13: NWS, HR, City Work, Vision, CAD, etc

Q14: What is the expected volume of documents to be stored in the new solution?

A14: Unknown at this time, but will definitely increase over time.

Q15: Does the City require multiple environments (ex: Production, QA/Test, Development) for the solution?

A15: Yes
